

- Seabed alteration (minor) \$500/\$1000
- Discharge (< 1 gal) \$500/\$1000
- MPWC zone violation \$500
- Attracting a white shark \$500
- Jade collection violation \$300

#### \* MFCMA

- Groundfish overages (≤ 25%) 2xFMV
- Failure to sort groundfish \$750
- Failure to report/file landings \$450
- No landing receipts aboard \$300








- 14 Flight Hours (Feb 24, Mar 12, Apr 1)
- Searched for specific vessels of interest to the Coast Guard
- Monitored all state MPAs for any fishing activity
- Served as spotter and survey aircraft for CDFG patrol vessels
- Logged position and name of commercial fishing vessels
- Logged positions and descriptions of commercial floats
- Logged position and name of commercial charter boats
- Monitored for whale encroachment by charter vessels
- Monitored for low-tide poaching activity
- Logged name and position of ships for IMO lane compliance
- Monitored for potential MPWC zone violations
- Inspected MPWC buoy positions
- Monitored for overflight zone violations and disturbance
- Logged position of shoreline construction activities
- Monitored for unlawful artifact & minerals extraction (coast)
- Monitored for white shark attraction activity at Ano Nuevo
