The Monterey Bay National Marine Sanctuary is located in the Heritage Harbor office complex above the tunnel in Monterey.

The nearest parking garage is on the corner of Pacific Street and Scott Street. There is a fee to park in the garage. You may opt to park in a different parking garage, or find street parking.

Within the Heritage Harbor office complex, the MBNMS office is closest to the corner of Pacific Street and Scott Street. If you enter the complex from this corner, Building 455 is situated at diagonal from the corner entrance. Conference Room door is on ground level, situated underneath and between the two staircases (Room 455B).

If you choose to enter the complex using the pedestrian bridge from the parking lot (near "A" icon in map below), walk towards the fountain in the middle of the complex. Upon reaching the fountain, turn right along the walking path; the MBNMS building is beyond the Old Brick

House, on the left side of the walking path. Conference Room door is on ground level, situated underneath and between the two staircases (Room 455B).
