Ship Strikes in Sanctuaries: New Mortality Model (John Calambokidis and Cotton Rockwood)

- Rockwood and Calambokidis summarized their recent paper (Cottonwood et al. 2017) and presented, "High mortality of blue, humpback and fin whales from modeling of US west coast vessel collisions"
- They concluded: important to revisit shipping routes in MBNMS (previous lane-setting did not consider ship strikes)

- On April 10th, Dr. Steven Haddock (MBARI) received the Ed Ricketts Memorial Award; and provided captivating lecture, "Beneath Pacific Tides: The wondrous glowing realm of deep-sea biodiversity"
