Snapshot Day - May 7th 2016



Snapshot Day is the oldest and largest single-day, annual water-quality monitoring event of its kind in California. On Snapshot Day, hundreds of volunteers collect water quality samples from rivers and streams in California's coastal watersheds that drain into Monterey Bay National Marine Sanctuary.

Volunteer in Monterey, San Luis Obispo, Santa Cruz and San Mateo Counties.
